

SARASOTA COUNTY GOVERNMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE

(FOR DISTRIBUTION TO CONTRACTORS, AND/OR THEIR INSURANCE PROVIDERS)

For those applicable Contracts/Agreements where insurance coverage is required, the Certificate of Insurance should include the following:

Specific date(s) of the event must be stated clearly on the certificate, if blanket coverage is not already in effect.

Type of Insurance Required: General Liability and Occurrence should be checked

Each Occurrence = \$1,000,000 or more

Damage to Rented Premises (Ea Occurrence) = \$50,000

Personal & Adv Injury = \$250,000 or more

General Aggregate = \$1,000,000 and up to \$2,000,000 is required, this amount will be determined by the County based on the nature of the event.

In the “Description of Operations/Special Provisions” section:

- Sarasota County Government is named as an additional insured, as their interests may appear on Commercial General Liability
